

Have students watch the video. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=JkCIJGXbfU>

Use the worksheet to check comprehension.

### Before Watching the Video

- **Introduce the topic** of ordering food at a restaurant. Discuss common phrases and vocabulary used in restaurant settings, such as "What would you like to order?", "To-go or for here?", and "I'd like..."
- **Review key words and phrases from the transcript** (e.g., steak, sandwich, pasta, ketchup, mustard, lettuce, salad, dressing, French, Italian). Write these on the board and provide examples.
- **Pre-teach Vocabulary**
- Ask students about their experiences ordering food. Have them share their favorite meals or restaurants.
- **Encourage** them to think about polite language used when ordering.
- Activate Prior Knowledge  
Tell students they'll watch a video where people order food at a restaurant. Their task is to listen carefully for the food items and drinks ordered, as well as the questions asked by the customers.
- Set a Purpose for Watching

### During Watching the Video

- First Viewing
- **Second Viewing** (Pause for Comprehension)  
Play the video again, pausing after each interaction. Ask guiding questions like:  
"What does the first customer want to order?"  
"What does the second customer order?"
- **Pair Work:** Have students work in pairs to discuss the answers to the guiding questions. Encourage them to compare notes and clarify any confusion.

### After Watching the Video

- Quiz Worksheet
- Homework/Extension Activity  
Assign students to write a short dialogue or script where they order food at a restaurant, including at least three food items and one drink. Encourage creativity and the use of vocabulary from the lesson.
